

FIRST STEP: Letter of Intent

All artists who attended the community workshop for the **California Leisure Open Space** on **November 18th, 2021** are eligible to submit a letter of intent to submit a proposal to the PAINT program.

A volunteer selection committee comprised of local residents will review all submitted information. They will select up to 5 artists to invite to the next phase. Those selected for the will be given information about how to submit a full proposal, through a formal Request For Proposals.

Guidelines

- Deadline to submit your Letter of Intent: Friday Monday, December 6th, by 5:00pm
- Keep it brief, 1-2 pages typed
- Submissions must be in the form of a .PDF document (If desired, you may submit up to 3 images of previous work, which should be embedded in the document and **not** submitted as an attachment/separate file.)

Please include the following:

• Your contact information

- o Name
- o Mailing address
- o Email address
- o Phone number
- o Website address or social link where your work can be viewed (*If you have one available*)

• Project concept or vision

- In 1-2 paragraphs, briefly describe your vision for the project.
 - Concepts you are working with, such as history, culture, economics, environment, location, etc...
 - How the project will look and feel
 - How community participation will be incorporated

• Community participation

List how various groups from the community will have an opportunity to participate with the project and how you might engage them.
